I know we say it every year, but where did the time go? It's been a busy year at Iron Gate. We re-opened the dining room in May and welcomed grocery guests back to our self-select pantry in December. It is a true joy to interact with our guests again. These past two years have reinforced the axiom, the only constant is change. But, change is what keeps us going forward and seeing what is around the next corner. At Iron Gate, we continue to meet the need. And the way we do this, is thanks to your generosity. This year, you have helped 34,979 families with groceries, 24,103 with kid's packs and served 204,798 meals! That's pretty incredible—all of those numbers are people FED!

As always, I am inspired and impressed by the people who give to us and the people we serve. Lawyers Fighting Hunger hosted another great Thanksgiving grocery pantry – providing funding and manpower to make bags to share with families. From a parking lot full of palletized food to 1,000 bags packed and ready to be delivered in the timespan of less than 2 hours!

I received an email after Thanksgiving from one of our pantry guests, D. She wrote on behalf of her household to express her deepest gratitude. Because of Iron Gate, they were able to have a delicious Thanksgiving dinner and have food left over to get them through the week. D is finishing her last semester in college on scholarship following an escape from an abusive marriage. She is the first in her family to attend college (in her 40s). D said she would not have been able to make it work without the help from Iron Gate and others. D wanted to share her story so that we will know how Iron Gate's help circles back into our community – D said she knows, of course, she is only one of many.

Wow! What an impact. Yes, she is one of many, but, everyone who visits Iron Gate has their own story and we are grateful D shared hers with us. Who knew 44 years ago our Founder's act of kindness would be helping people 44 years later in so many ways. Never underestimate the impact of a good deed and the ripple effect it will have.

As the year comes to an end. I want to again thank you for your commitment to Iron Gate and those is need, because of you we can continue to feed people EVERY DAY! Wishing you peace and happiness in the new year. Welcome 2023!

## Behind the Scenes

Every day Operations Staff at Iron Gate pick up from grocery stores across the city, in partnership with the Food Bank of Eastern Oklahoma. These pickups include a wide range of food items; like canned goods, deli meats, frozen meals, bread, the list goes on. Our



Pantry Team then processes, sorts and packages these items into grocery bags to distribute via our food pantry. This past November we hit an ALL TIME high in the number of pounds from grocery store pickups. What once used to be 8,000 pounds now has turned into 69,000 pounds of food. The demand for food continues to increase with inflation. These grocery store pickups help us meet that demand. A special thank you to our staff and volunteers for their hard work behind the scenes in helping families receive food to put on their tables tonight.
